1. October Devotion

Our October devotion will end on Thursday 31st October. We will have an Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from 5:30pm, rosary at 6pm, and burning of petitions after 7pm Mass. Everyone is invited to attend.

2. The Schedule of Mass on All Saints and All Souls

(1) All Saints (1-11-2024): 9am, 12.30pm and 7pm
(It is a Holyday of Obligation, mass is compulsory)

(2) All Souls (2-11-2024): 10am, 1.30pm and 6:30pm

3. No 6pm Mass next Saturday

There is no 6pm mass on Saturday, 2nd November 2024, because of All Souls mass at 6.30pm.

4. All Souls Mass

We have three masses next Saturday, 2nd November. We are all encouraged to come and pray for our dead relatives, friends, colleagues and neighbours. At the 6.30 pm mass, we will lay candles around the sanctuary symbolising the souls of the people we will pray for. We encourage each family to get at least a candle for their deceased loved ones. The Memorial Candles are available in the repository.

5. Mustard Seed Youth Project

We have scheduled a trip to the Canterbury Cathedral on Saturday 9th November. It's part of the Mustard Seed Project. It is open to young people from ages 14 to 25. 8. Parish Projects

Update on our parish project

1) **Upgrade of the sound system:** We want to correct an error in our publication from last week.

- The amount needed to complete the sound system is 12,100, but we mistakenly published £12,500. Apologies for the mistake.

This sum is for THE REMAINING 9 loudspeakers, Audio Mixer and Amplifier.

- ◆ New donation: £600
- ◆ New Balance: £11,500.

We have progressed from 15 speakers; we are now down to 9.

2) **New Mass books:** 1080 copies To complete our mass books for years A (volumes 1 & 2), B (volumes 1 & 2) and C (volumes 1 & 2).

From 2100 copies, we are now down to 1080 copies.
