CHRIST OUR LORD IS RISEN, ALLELUIA!

Christ our Lord is risen, Alleluia! This is the day that the Lord has made, let us rejoice and be glad. Jesus is risen, never to die again. After the anguish of the last few days, it is time to rejoice.

With his resurrection, Jesus makes a very important statement. That, he is both the Lord of the dead, and of the living. We die with him through our Lenten celebrations. So, let us rise with him through the same power that raised him (Ro 8:11).

Therefore, as Paul instructed us in the second reading, we must seek the things of light, things that are noble, true, just and that glorify God. We must seek heavenly things, and live as liberated people, and citizens of heaven.

Through this, Paul calls us to be aware of our new, exalted position in Christ. Let us be happy, and let us rejoice in what God has done for us today in Christ. Let's sing with the psalmist: "This day was made by the Lord, we are happy.

let us ask for the grace to enter into the joy of Jesus himself, the seed that fell to the ground and died, and is now bearing abundant fruit, full of new life. Hallelujah, Hallelujah

FIRST READING**ACTS 10:34,37-43**

Peter addressed Cornelius and his household: 'You must have heard about the recent happenings in Judaea; about Jesus of Nazareth and how he began in Galilee, after John had been preaching baptism. God had anointed him with the Holy Spirit and with power, and because God was with him, Jesus went about doing good and curing all who had fallen into the power of the devil. Now I, and those with me, can witness to everything he did throughout the countryside of Judaea and in Jerusalem itself: and also to the fact that they killed him by hanging him on a tree, yet three days afterwards God raised him to life and allowed him to be seen, not by the whole people but only by certain witnesses God had chosen beforehand. Now we are those witnesses – we have eaten and drunk with him after his resurrection from the dead – and he has ordered us to proclaim this to his people and to tell them that God has appointed him to judge everyone, alive or dead. It is to him that all the prophets bear this witness: that all who believe in Jesus will have their sins forgiven through his name.'
